ABOUT GROVE PARK

With almost 500 homes, a neighborhood park, walking trail, and several privately-owned lakes that add charm and beauty to the neighborhood – not to mention the wildlife – Grove Park is a diverse, vibrant place to live and raise a family. While many of the people that live here are second-generation residents, others have more recently moved to the neighborhood and come from as far away as Asia, Africa, Latin-America and Eastern Europe. Neighbors enjoy close proximity to uptown, the University Area, and the amazing international restaurants of east Charlotte, together with friendly, welcoming neighbors.

OUR SCHOOLS

Our children are welcome at the three public schools serving our neighborhood: Joseph A. Grier Academy, an elementary school at 8330 Grier Road; Northridge Middle School at 7601 The Plaza; and Rocky River High School, 10505 Clear Creek Commerce Drive.

OUR NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION

The Grove Park Neighborhood Association (GPNA) is a non-profit 501c3 organization that works with residents, local officials, businesses, schools, and other community organizations to help strengthen our neighborhood, our schools and the larger community that we are a part of. Membership is conferred upon all residents that live or own property in the neighborhood. Annual dues of \$20 are voluntary and help support community projects and events.

OUR BLOCK CAPTAIN PROGRAM

The neighborhood is divided into sections, each with its own block captain who deliver the quarterly Grove Park Gazette and other flyers, and helps support the Neighborhood Watch.

OUR NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH PROGRAM

Grove Park is a safe, friendly neighborhood. We enjoy a close relationship with our local police officers, and have a Watch program to help neighbors stay informed about any crime and safety issues that affect our community.



OUR MEETINGS AND EVENTS

There are many opportunities to get engaged in the life of the neighborhood. The Neighborhood Association hosts quarterly neighborhood meetings. Annual events consist of the Spring Garden Tour, 4th of July parade, Fall Fest, and Winterfest celebration.

OUR GARDEN CLUB

The Grove Park-Ravenwood Garden Club meets monthly, typically on a Saturday morning. Annual field trips and the club's annual holiday brunch are a big hit. The signature event is the annual spring garden tour showcasing gardens in both participating neighborhoods, plus art and live music by local artists, a plant sale, and refreshments in many of the gardens. Whether you have a green thumb or not, all are welcome.

OUR BOOK CLUB

Inklings Book Club meets monthly in private homes to share the love of reading, coffee or vino, and good conversation. It, too, joins residents from both Grove Park and Ravenwood neighborhoods.

OUR CRAFTER GROUPS

For those that love crafts, opportunities exist to gather to knit, crochet, paint or any other craft that can readily be done indoors.


